- Discussed grants- Lions Club, Kiwanis, Legion
- Fall Kick-off
- Funds \$6222.15 (surfacing/drainage will be covered by school)
 - There is \$12,184.15 in the playground PTO fund as of now- this includes flower sales, PTO, and We Energies
- Jeff G said there is money in the budget for the playground
- Heather has some fundraising opportunities
 - Brat Fry at the Tractor Pulls/Truck Show June 11-12th
 - could do our own stand and sell items like Walking Tacos
 - Danny's Meat said we could work for him
 - He will give us a \$500 donation that normally would be paid to rent the building
 - He will pay \$15/hour for anyone that works
 - Will need a minimum of 5 people per day
 - Kiwanis Booth during the fair
 - Will pay \$10/ hour per person for volunteering
